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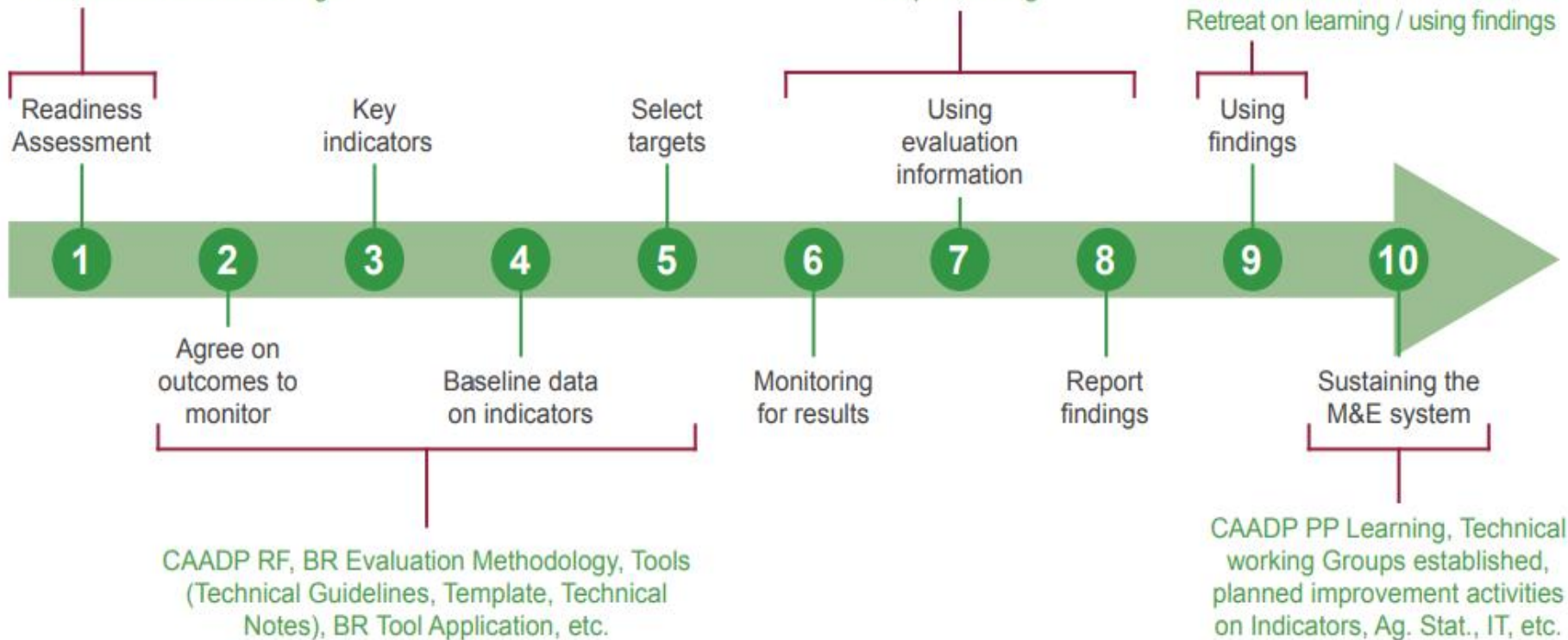

# Summary of BR Results

- The overall average score for the region is 4.11, which indicates that the region is not on track in meeting the CAADP/ Malabo commitments when assessed against the 7.28 benchmark for 2020.
- This also represents a 3.5% decline in performance when compared to the 2019 BR for the region.
- Among the eleven (11) Member States, none is on track which represents a 66.7% decrease from the number of Member States that were on track in the inaugural BR but represents no change from the 2019 BR.
