# Definitions of keynotes

## 1. HouseHold Level

  - ii. Gender role cancellation grooming at young age
  - iii. Addressing GBV and gender inequality at home level

# Levels of ownership as Leaders

## 2. Community Level

- a. Issues of GBV impact of climate such as drought, floods etc lead to poor economy causing displacement and migrations. This leads to increased GBV cases (both men and women) and sexual abuse. Also leads to conflicts for natural resources. Here are some solutions:
  - i. Capacity development for the community including social workers on gender and climate change matters.
  - ii. Improved data management and technology for better decision making and to better prepare for future responses to climate change
  - iii. Advocacy for improved responses
  - iv. Protection of human rights as our means of commitment and responsibilities
  - v. Have good policies and frameworks that address the gender and climate change matters as leaders ensuring inclusivity
  - vi. Have established institutions used for reporting and accountability purposes for gender and climate change victims
